Kepner also works closely with the AgReliant stations at Morris MN and Kenyon MN. The breeders at those stations test hundreds of thousands of plants in their nurseries and plots. Kepner states, *“It’s exciting to see what’s in our product pipeline. Having the research stations right here is significant because the products are developed in our environment.”*
